- 1. BASKETRY – “Colorful Tray”:** one-day class, Tuesday, May 14th. Enjoy weaving a functional tray while using a non-traditional material. Crate a one-of-a-kind tray using a pre-painted heavy watercolor paper that will be cut into 1/2 inch strips. The layered border makes this a sturdy, durable piece. The paper has been painted with fabric paints that are permanent on the cotton papers. No two sheets are ever painted with the same color patterns and many color choices will be provided.
