4-H is the Youth Development program of North Carolina Cooperative Extension. Camps are open to ages specific to the age appropriateness of the activities.

4-H Enrollment

Camp Registration

Register and pay for classes using the Eventbrite Link provided. Each camp has a corresponding link. If you elect to pay by cash or check payment must be made within 5 working days of registration in order to hold your spot.

Additional Information:

- Fees cover insurance and supplies. Camp fees are non-refundable, unless the camp is canceled.
- Space is limited, so once enrolled, your child is expected to attend and participate. If your child can no longer attend, please contact the 4-H Office as soon as possible so we can offer the space to the waitlist.
- Start and end times are enforced. Please arrive on time and pick up your children on time. We are unable to wait for late campers when departing for “away” trips, due to schedules established with our partnering organizations.
- If your child will be taking any medication (prescription or over-the-counter) during a 4-H camp, please advise the 4-H staff and supply the medication in a labeled container and instructions to the staff.
